ENEL

LOCATION: UNITED STATES INDUSTRY: RENEWABLE ENERGY

Enel produces renewable energy. The company began in Italy in 1962 but has now expanded to operations in more than 53 countries, including in the United States and Canada. Originally, Enel focused their work on hydroelectricity but now invests in solar, wind, nuclear, and other renewable energy sources. In their North American market, Enel has 115 remote sites which require security during their construction and during normal operation.

CHALLENGES

- Monitor solar farms, hydroelectric sites, wind farms, and other remote sites
- · Deter theft and vandalism
- Real-time views of remote properties for operational purposes
- · Protect equipment and materials
- · Patrol who has access to locations
- Install security with no access to hardwire connections
